### **Week 2: Who we are (responsibilities)**

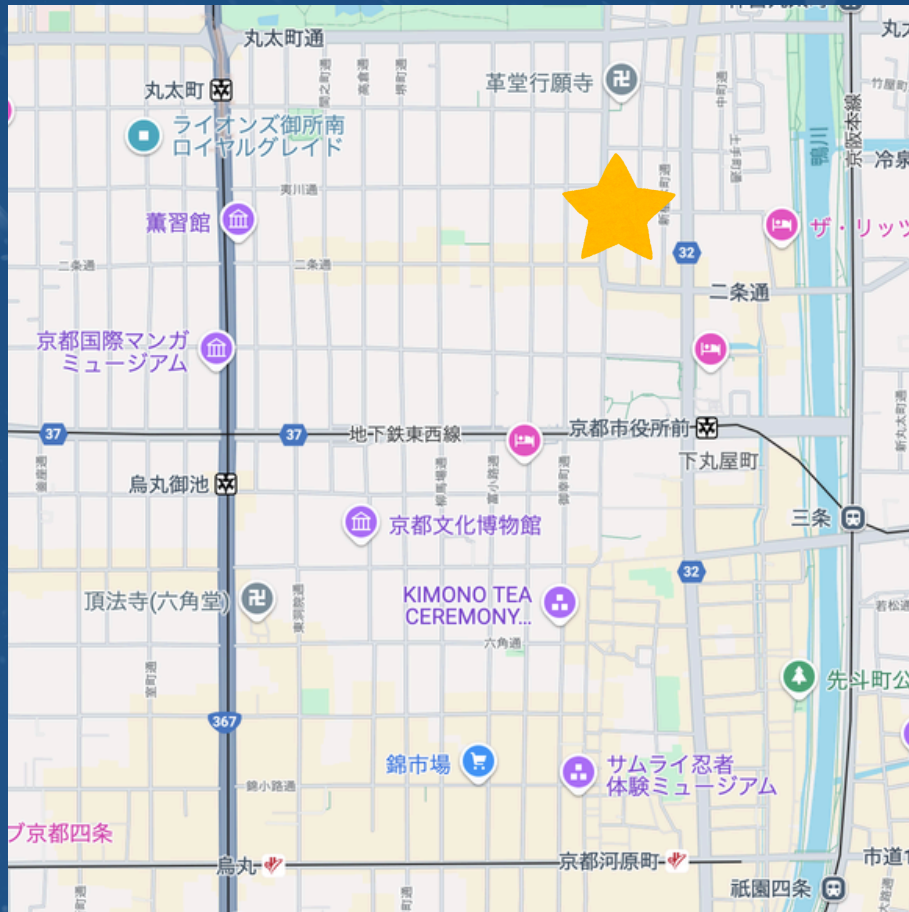
Inquiry into self-identity, human relationships and the essence of being human. Theme activities: five senses stimulation, Personal reflection journals, Family tree projects, and more
